Immanuel Lutheran Church to Host Gospel Concert Musicians

Immanuel Lutheran Church in Plainview will be hosting Dave Anderson and Roger Walck for an evening worship concert on Wednesday, August 7, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. Dave's first concert in Plainview was in the 1980's. Now, we are excited to be included on his farewell tour. Dave and Roger combined, have 100 years experience in music ministry! The audience will often be invited to sing along with Dave and Roger.

In addition to their music experience, they are ambassadors for the Shepherd's Canyon Retreat ministry. Shepherd's Canyon Retreat provides week-long counseling retreats for men and women in full-time ministry who are in the midst of burnout, stress, depression, and conflicts of all kinds. The Shepherd's Canyon Retreat ministry is based in Arizona.

On August 13, 1993, Dave Anderson, his wife Barbara, and five others survived a plane crash in the Bering Sea. The seven missionaries were in 41-degree water for about an hour. Their rescue has been called the most dramatic air/sea rescue in aviation history. During the evening, Dave will share highlights from their crash and rescue story. If you have not heard the rescue story before, you don't want to miss hearing about this miracle!
